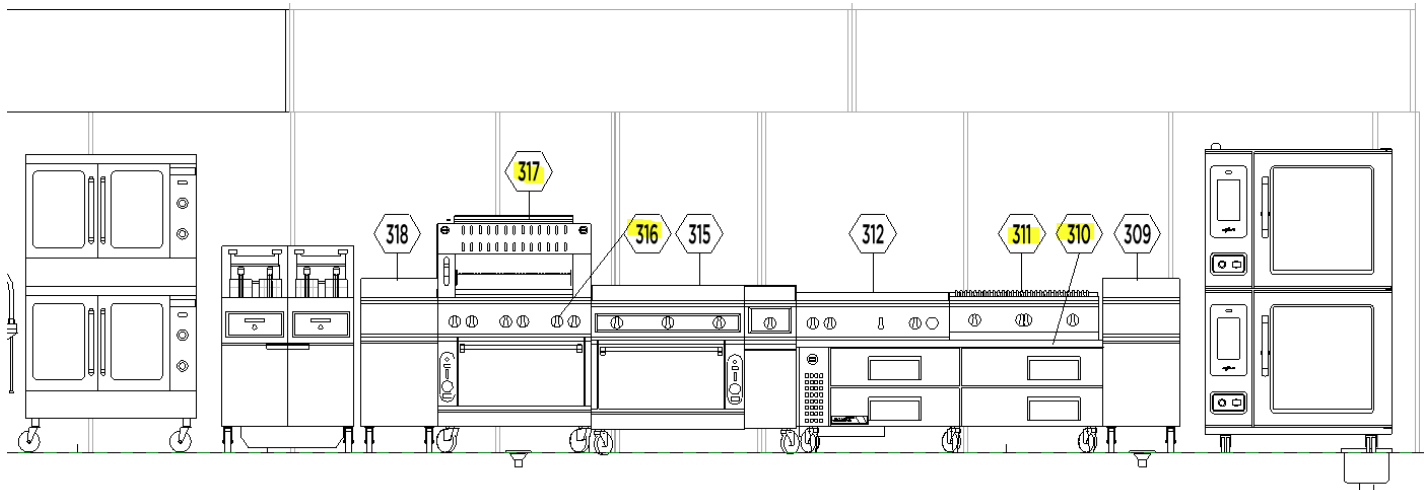
Our sheet size is 30 x 42.

- Item #316 – Vulcan Heavy-Duty Range, 36", 6 Open Burners; similar to, if not, model # V4B36 – EXISTING –
